**LAWS FOR HIGH SCHOOL RUGBY
(u19 – u/14 AGE GROUPS)**



ALL THE LAWS IN THE OFFICIAL LAW BOOK WITH AMENDMENTS BY THE IRB AS RECEIVED FOR 2010, ARE APPLICABLE WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS.

Law 20: SCRUM

1. No scrum must be wheeled intentionally – however, certain dynamics may cause a scrum to be wheeled.
2. The wheel scrum application of 45 degrees for u/19 law variations is applicable with the following application for clarity purposes:
The referee is not to blow the whistle when the scrum gets close to 45 degrees, but to act once it has reached and gone beyond 45 degrees. (The reason is to bring it in line with the application of the recent past.) Awarding of the ball remains as stipulated in the law book for u/19 rugby.

GENERAL:

1. All laws as per the 2010 law book is applicable and where there is conflict, the u/19 law variations as stipulated in the law book takes preference.
